Complete 7 Safety in Schools courses and a teacher assigned project.

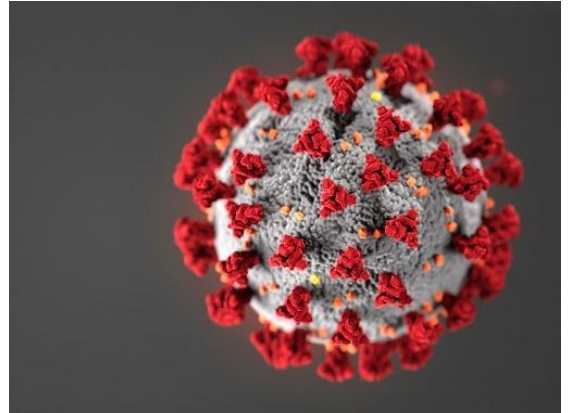
AGR 3000

Celebrating 100,000 Certificates

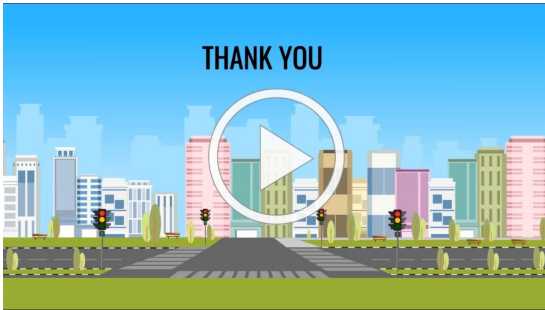
We could all use a bit of good news during this stressful and uncertain time and we have got you covered!
